Special Meeting of Council
September 20, 2006

The special meeting of Council was called to order by Vice President Kulish at 5:00 p.m. in the Municipal Center, 925 Old Clairton Road. Following the Pledge of Allegiance, Council Members Cmar, King, Kulish, Oskin, and Serapiglia answered to roll call. Chief Reagan and Solicitor LoPresti were also present. Council President Militzer arrived at 5:03 p.m. Council Member Weir, Mayor Green, Engineer Omer and Public Service Coordinator were absent.

President Militzer arrived and temporarily adjourned the special meeting for an executive session to discuss a personnel matter. He reconvened the meeting at 5:20 p.m.

Dr. Kulish moved to adopt Resolution No. 26-2006, "APPOINTING DOUGLAS C. ARNDT INTERIMBOROUGHMANAGER FOR THE PERIOD OCTOBER 2, 2006 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2007," subject to the revisions discussed and agreed to by Mr. Arndt and Council this evening, seconded by Mrs. Cmar and carried unanimously.

GENERAL BUSINESS:

Dr. Kulish welcomed Mr. Arndt and hoped he would become the permanent Manager.

Mr. Oskin also welcomed Mr. Arndt. Mr. Oskin reported he attended the TJ Youth Football fundraiser Saturday with the PovertyNeck Hillbillies, and thought it was run wonderfully.

Mr. King welcomed Mr. Arndt and advised he would like to start working on the budget soon.

Mr. Serapiglia advised Mr. Arndt that he had entertained the idea of combining jobs and eliminating the Borough Manager position. He hoped that Mr. Arndt would renew his faith in the position. Mr. Serapiglia asked Mr. Arndt if he produced a newsletter in his previous community, and he replied yes. Mr. Serapiglia advised he would like to see a quarterly newsletter produced by the Borough again.

Mrs. Cmar, Mr. LoPresti, Chief Reagan and Mr. Militzer all welcomed Mr. Arndt.

Mr. Militzer announced for the newspapers that Mr. Arndt's start date is October 2nd.

Mr. Militzer reported the fundraiser on Saturday was used as a test for the County Emergency Management equipment on a large crowd.

Mr. Militzer adjourned the meeting at 5:30 p.m. with an executive session to follow to discuss personnel matters on a motion by Dr. Kulish, seconded by Mr. King and carried unanimously.
